Bahamas Relief Efforts

On September 1st, Hurricane Dorian swept across the Bahamas as a Category 5 hurricane - the strongest to ever hit the archipelago - with winds up to 200mph. The hurricane hovered over the island for a day and a half, battering the Grand Bahama and Great Abaco islands with heavy rains, storm surges, and winds causing severe damage and destruction to thousands of homes and over 50 deaths. Three weeks after Hurricane Dorian and Tropical Storm Humberto, humanitarian relief supplies and aid continue to be shipped and distributed to survivors.
